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

15 transportation services for senior citizens within the Municipality of Anchorage.



Subject: A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING A FEDERAL HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES GRANT AWARD THROUGH THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES, IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$572,250) TO THE STATE DIRECT/FEDERAL PASS-THROUGH GRANTS FUND (231), PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, FOR COORDINATED SENIOR TRANSPORTATION SERVICES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE

The attached resolution appropriates a grant to the Municipality of Anchorage funding senior transportation. The Municipality of Anchorage received a grant award notification from the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services. The grant is in the amount of \$572,250 and covers the period of July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012. This Federal Older Americans Act grant through the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services assists in the funding of AnchorRIDES, a coordinated transportation service for Anchorage's senior citizens and people with disabilities. The required local 10% match of \$63,583 is provided through fuel and staff time provided as 'in-kind' support to this grant from the 2011 and 2012 Operating Budgets of the Public Transportation Department.
