The Municipality of Anchorage has been 16 awarded a grant in the amount of \$175,000 with a required local contribution of \$3,848 for 17 a total program budget of \$178,848. These amounts are requested to be appropriated to the 18 Federal Grants Fund (241) for use by the Anchorage Police Department. This grant will

begin on October 1, 2011 and will end on September 30, 2012.
