THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:



That the sum of Sixty-two Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-five Dollars (\$62,795) is appropriated from the State of Alaska, Department of Health and Social Services as a supplemental award to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231), to provide encouragement and support to breastfeeding women participating in the supplemental nutrition services program in the Department of Health and Human Services.

Subject: A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING SIXTY-TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$62,795) FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES AS A SUPPLEMENTAL AWARD TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231) TO PROVIDE ENCOURAGEMENT AND SUPPORT TO BREASTFEEDING WOMEN PARTICIPATING IN THE SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION SERVICES PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.

These funds will allow for the Peer Breast Feeding Project within the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Supplemental Nutrition Program. This supplemental award brings the total funding to \$1,312,459. The period of the grant is July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012.

The WIC program provides encouragement and support to breastfeeding woman participating in the supplemental nutrition program in the Department of Health and Human Services.

The Municipality of Anchorage, Department of Health and Human Services received the first grant for WIC services in February 1977 and has operated the program continually since then. Funding for breastfeeding support has been allocated since 2008. These funds will allow for continued support of this service.

Under the terms of this grant program staff will:

- Provide encouragement and support of breastfeeding women
- Provide loaned breast pumps to active clients
- Provide nutrition education and State warrants purchasing supplemental foods for breastfeeding women who are income eligible and at nutritional risk.
- Maintain financial records, which are readily accessible for State and Federal Review.

Provide reports as required by Federal regulations.
