

SUBJECT: APPROPRIATION OF TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$20,000)
FROM TARGET CORPORATION TO THE ANCHORAGE PUBLIC
LIBRARY, MISCELLANEOUS OPERATIONAL GRANTS FUND (261),
FOR THE COMMUNITY READ PROGRAM 2012

Target Corporation has partnered with the Anchorage Public Library for the Community Read Program. This program will be implemented in two parts; the first to start February 2012, the second May 2012.

The Anchorage Public Library's family reading program will have two components – a one book/one community reading program that will take place in the winter (February – March) and kick off events (Reading Rendezvous and Reading Rendezvous Too) for the summer reading program (May). The community will be encouraged to read individually, through book clubs, or within the family. The Community Read program is also scheduled during the Iditarod Dog Sled Race and the library will partner, once again, with the Iditarod Trail Education Committee/Teacher on the Trail program.
