A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING ONE HUNDRED NINETY-NINE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$199,000) FROM THE SOUTHCENTRAL FOUNDATION TO THE FEDERAL GRANTS FUND (241) TO PARTIALLY FUND THE EMERGENCY ALCOHOL COMMUNITY SERVICES PROGRAM, ANCHORAGE SAFETY PATROL CONTRACT IN THE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, since 1991 Title 47.37.170 of the Alaska State Statutes requires a person who appears to be incapacitated by alcohol or drugs in a public place be taken into custody by a peace officer or a member of the emergency service patrol and immediately brought to an approved public treatment facility or another approved health facility; and

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Safety Center is a municipal-owned and maintained facility used for this purpose and funded from two sources: Municipal operating dollars (87%) and grant funds provided by Southcentral Foundation (13%) since 1996; now, therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the sum of One Hundred Ninety-nine Thousand Dollars (\$199,000) is appropriated from the Southcentral Foundation to the Federal Grants Fund (241) to partially fund the Health and Human Services Department Emergency Alcohol Community Services Program, Anchorage Safety Patrol contract.

Section 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.

The Municipality of Anchorage, Health and Human Services Department has entered into a professional services contract with Southcentral Foundation to receive \$199,000 to partially fund the Emergency Alcohol Community Services Program, Anchorage Safety Patrol contract. This contract currently provides public inebriate pick-up and monitored sleep-off services.

The Health and Human Services Department received final notification of this continuation funding grant award in August 2011. The grant period is January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011.
