7 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:



7 **FEDERAL GRANTS FUND (241), FOR FAMILY PLANNING**
8 **SERVICES IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN**

12 The Department of Health and Human Services has received a grant award of
13 \$1,010,090 from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services for the
14 provision of Family Planning Services. The period of the grant is from June 30,
15 2011, through June 29, 2012.

16
17 The Municipality of Anchorage has provided family planning services with federal
18 grant funding since 1970. The focus of the program is to provide low-income
19 women and men the ability to plan the timing and spacing of their children and to
20 prevent teen pregnancies.

21
22 Under the terms of this grant the staff of the Department of Health and Human
23 Services will:

- 24
25 • Provide clinical reproductive health services for low-income women, men, and
26 teens;
27 • Work in partnerships with other groups and agencies that serve similar priority
28 populations, including low-income women and high-risk, and runaway youth;
29 • Provide pregnancy testing and counseling;
30 • Provide services to adolescents that include: encouraging the postponement of
31 sexual activity, skills to prevent sexual coercion, assessment for parental
32 involvement; and increased emphasis on reaching racial/ethnic minority youth
33 groups;
34 • Increase services to hard-to-reach populations by partnering with community
35 and faith-based organizations that have a stake in the prevention of unintended
36 pregnancies and the transmission of sexually transmitted infections;
37 • Provide comprehensive reproductive health services to include necessary lab
38 tests for anemia, pregnancy, sexually transmitted infections, screenings for

breast and cervical cancer, and education and counseling in the selection and use of a contraceptive method;

- Increase services to males, emphasizing shared responsibility for preventing unintended pregnancy and sexually transmitted infections;
- Collect and maintain statistical data as required for Title X;
- Provide HIV Testing and Counseling following the guidelines of the 2006 Center for Disease Control revised recommendations for HIV Testing in Healthcare Settings.
- Maintain documentation and records within the requirements of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) that are readily accessible for fiscal review; and
- Provide reports as required by federal regulations.
