A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING A FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA) GRANT OF ONE MILLION TWENTY HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$1,020,152) THOUSAND ONE CONTRIBUTION OF TWENTY THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED THREE DOLLARS (\$20,403) FROM THE 2011 OPERATING BUDGET AREAWIDE GENERAL FUND (101). PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, TO THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION CAPITAL FUND (485), PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, FOR CAPITAL ASSISTANCE, AND APPROPRIATING THREE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-SEVEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,497,000) OF THE GRANT AND A CONTRIBUTION OF ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$174,654) FROM THE 2011 OPERATING BUDGET. AREAWIDE GENERAL FUND (101), PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, TO THE FEDERAL GRANTS FUND (241), PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, FOR FLEET MAINTENANCE ASSISTANCE, THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) PARATRANSIT SERVICES AND FACILITIES MAINTENANCE.

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WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage periodically applies for and receives FTA grants for capital, operational and other purposes in connection with operation of its transit system; now, therefore,

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THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

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Section 1. That the Administration is authorized to accept 2011 FTA Section 5307 grants.

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<u>Section 2.</u> That One Million Twenty Thousand One Hundred Fifty-two Dollars (\$1,020,152) is hereby appropriated as a grant from the Federal Transit Administration to the Public Transportation Capital Fund (485), Public Transportation Department, to fund the purchase of Public Transportation capital improvements.

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<u>Section 3.</u> That Twenty Thousand Four Hundred Three Dollars (\$20,403) from the Areawide General Fund (101), Public Transportation Department 2011 Operating Budget, is hereby appropriated as a contribution to the Public Transportation Capital Fund (485), Public Transportation Department, to fund the support of Municipal Central Service Agencies to this grant.

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Section 4. That Three Million Four Hundred Ninety-seven Thousand Dollars (\$3,497,000) from the Federal Transit Administration is appropriated to the Federal Grants Fund (241), Public Transportation Department, to fund ADA transportation service and a transportation skills assessment center providing a travel training program for people with disabilities and for senior citizens and maintenance of buses and bus stop and transit facilities.

That One Hundred Seventy-four Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-four Dollars (\$174,654) is contributed from 2011 Operating Budget, Areawide General Fund (101), Public Transportation Department, to the Federal Grants Fund (241), Public Transportation Department, to fund support by Municipal Central Service Agencies and to match a transportation skills assessment center and travel training program for people with disabilities and for senior citizens and purchase of ADA transportation service

Section 6. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.

Subject: THE ATTACHED ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION APPROPRIATES A FEDERAL

TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA) GRANT OF ONE MILLION TWENTY THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$1,020,152) AND A CONTRIBUTION OF TWENTY THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED THREE DOLLARS (\$20,403) FROM THE 2011 OPERATING BUDGET AREAWIDE GENERAL FUND (101), PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, TO THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION CAPITAL FUND (485), PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, FOR CAPITAL ASSISTANCE, AND APPROPRIATING THREE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$3,497,000) OF THE GRANT THOUSAND CONTRIBUTION OF ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$174,654) FROM THE OPERATING BUDGET, AREAWIDE GENERAL FUND (101), PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, TO THE FEDERAL GRANTS FUND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT. FOR FLEET **PUBLIC** MAINTENANCE ASSISTANCE, THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) PARATRANSIT SERVICES AND FACILITIES MAINTENANCE.

The ADA Operating Assistance portion provides \$448,000 in grant funds requiring a local match of \$112,000. The local match and \$62,654 to fund support of Municipal Central Service Agencies will be contributed from the Public Transportation Department's 2011 approved Operating Budget. This portion of the grant will fund purchased ADA service and the operation of a Transportation Skills Assessment and Travel Training program to ensure transportation for the elderly and persons with disabilities is provided to them in a reasonable and cost effective manner. The transit fleet, bus stop and other facilities maintenance portion of \$3,049,000 in grant funds requires a local match of \$762,250. Inkind support to fleet and facilities maintenance from the 2011 Operating Budget of the Public Transportation Department will provide this required local match.

The capital assistance portion provides \$1,020,152 in grant funds and requires a local match of \$255,038. It will be provided from voter approved General Obligations Bonds and direct and legislative grants. The capital assistance funds preventive and capital maintenance items/vehicle overhauls, replacement of up to two paratransit vehicles, fleet improvements, automated operating systems, passenger shelters, Information Technology hardware and software, and fleet support vehicles and equipment. The contribution of \$20,403 is to fund the support of Municipal Central Service Agencies to this grant. It will be funded from the Public Transportation Department's 2011 Operating Budget.
