A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, CONFIRMING AND LEVYING ASSESSMENTS FOR THE WATER SPECIAL IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN TURNAGAIN HEIGHTS WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 1416, SETTING DATE OF PAYMENT AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES AND INTEREST IN THE EVENT OF DELINQUENCY.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Soz AR 2011-302 (5- Amended)

 <u>Section 1.</u> The water improvements authorized in ordinance AO 2007-051 have been completed and costs for the improvements computed. Water assessments are levied against the property benefited by said improvements as set forth on the attached assessment roll.

Section 3. Assessments shall be paid in annual installments, in accordance with the Anchorage Water Utility Tariff. The first installment is due by March 31, 2012, and is payable on the same day of each subsequent year. Interest on unpaid installments starts to accrue on March 1, 2012. An installment payment shall be applied first to accrued interest then to principal. A penalty


of eight percent (8%) shall be added to any assessment, or assessment installment, not paid before the date of delinquency. The assessment, installment and penalty shall draw interest at the rate of eight percent (8%) per annum until paid. For delinquencies, payment shall be applied in accordance with AMC 19.20.260.

<u>Section 4.</u> A special assessment Collection Charge, as authorized in Rules 8.4 and 13.1 of the Anchorage Water Utility Tariff, in effect at the time the assessment is levied, will be charged to those properties identified in this resolution.

Section 5. Within thirty (30) days after the passage of this resolution, the Municipal Treasurer shall mail a notice to any owners of property whose assessment, schedule of payments, delinquencies, or amount of penalty and interest has been changed as a result of the public hearing concerning this resolution. Not more than sixty (60) days nor less than thirty (30) days before the date the assessment or the first payment of the assessment becomes delinquent, the treasurer shall mail a payment notice to each property owner; but the failure to mail the notice shall in no way affect any liability for or enforcement of payment of all or any part of the special assessment levied by this resolution.

<u>Section 6.</u> This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.

On April 17, 2007, the Municipal Assembly approved Ordinance Number 2007-051, creating Turnagain Heights Water Special Assessment District (WID) No. 1416. At creation the total WID project costs were estimated at \$1,229,140.16. Construction of the water improvements has been completed, including approximately 1,900 linear feet of 8-inch water main, service connections to twenty-nine (29) properties, and other appurtenances required for a public water system. The final certified cost of the water improvements to be levied against benefited properties is \$1,037,325.12.

The Anchorage Water & Wastewater Utility (AWWU) sent certified letters to all affected property owners informing them of the assessment and proposed levy action, and inviting them to attend a public meeting held on November 2, 2011. All inquiries received have been addressed or answered.

The passage of this resolution will have a fiscal impact on the following three (3) Municipal owned parcels.
