Section 1. The sum of Eight Hundred Forty Thousand One Hundred Thirty-eight Dollars (\$840.138) is hereby appropriated from the FHWA, through the State of Alaska DOT&PF, to the State Categorical Grants - Pass-Thru Fund (231) for the Community Development Department, Planning Division, Transportation Planning Section, AMATS Program.

Subject: A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND ONE

HUNDRED THIRTY-EIGHT DOLLARS (\$840,138) FROM THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION (FHWA), THROUGH THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES (DOT&PF), TO THE STATE DIR/FED PASS-THRU GRANTS FUND (231) UNDER THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT, PLANNING DIVISION, TRANSPORTATION PLANNING SECTION, FOR THE 2012 ANCHORAGE METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION

SOLUTIONS (AMATS) PROGRAM.

An Assembly Resolution is requested to appropriate \$840,138 from the FHWA through the State of Alaska DOT&PF, to the State Dir/Fed Pass-Thru Grants Fund (231) under the Community Development Department, Planning Division, Transportation Planning Section, for the AMATS Program. This grant is an annual appropriation and is effective through December 31, 2012.

The FHWA of the United States Department of Transportation, through the DOT&PF, makes funding available on an annual basis to the Municipality to supplement existing local financial support for the AMATS planning process. Based on a state allocation formula, \$840,138 will be made available for CY 2012 from Alaska's federal Metropolitan Planning (PL) funds pending formal notification by the DOT&PF of the statewide PL funds availability. These PL monies may only be used to fund expenses incurred in relation to the AMATS planning process. They may not be used for any other purpose. If not utilized by the Municipality, these funds will revert to the State to be redistributed to other areas.

This funding will be utilized during the upcoming calendar year to enable staff to perform local and regional transportation plans and programs. PL funds are not used for project design and construction; they will continue to support existing municipal staff positions and professional services contractors acting on behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO).

The FHWA stipulates federal dollars may provide not more than 90.97% of the total basic program. Local funding must support at least 9.03% of the program. The minimum required local match is \$83,395. The Community Development Department will supply the entire required local match through provision of in-kind services. These funds are already allocated within the Department's operating budget, and do not require additional appropriation.
