**Subject:** A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING NINE HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$935) FROM A HAIRCUTTING FUNDRAISER TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES ANIMAL CONTROL DONATION ACCOUNT, MISCELLANEOUS OPERATIONAL GRANTS FUND (261) FOR GROOMING PETS IN THE CARE OF THE ANCHORAGE ANIMAL CARE AND CONTROL CENTER THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.

The Anchorage Animal Care and Control Center (AACCC) promotes animal welfare and adoptions through educational programs, participation in community events, websites and social media, and partnerships with a variety of organizations. Staff and volunteers strive to increase the health and adoptability of pets through medical care, exercise and play, behavioral training, socialization, and grooming.

In September 2011, Patrick Lomantini, of Lomantini The Salon, was in Anchorage as part of his 50 Haircuts in 50 States in 50 Days Tour. The tour began in August in Augusta, Maine and was completed in September in Wichita, Kansas. Local salon, Inspirations, hosted the world record-breaking event which included the goal of 1,500 haircuts to raise funds for local animal welfare organizations. At the event, haircuts were free and donations were accepted which resulted in \$935 for the Anchorage Animal Care and Control Center. Mr. Lomantini's intent was for donations to be used for grooming animals at each shelter he partnered with during the tour.

It is not uncommon for dogs and cats arriving at AACCC to need grooming as some are extremely dirty with severe matting, sometimes covering their entire body. At times grooming is accomplished to increase the adoptability of the animal, but is often done for the health of the animal as the neglected state they arrive in can cause pain and lead to infection and other problems. While AACCC works with some local groomers that donate services, they are not always available or immediately able to help animals with urgent needs. Thus, the funds will be used to pay for grooming services when necessary.

WHEREAS Patrick Lomantini is striving to break a world record by doing 50 haircuts in 50 states in 50 days to benefit animals; and

WHEREAS Mr. Lomantini was recently in Anchorage to do his Alaskan haircuts; and

WHEREAS Mr. Lomantini requested that donations from his haircuts be made to Anchorage Animal Care & Control; and

WHEREAS his efforts raised Nine Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars (\$935) in donations made to Animal Care & Control; and

WHEREAS animals coming in to the Animal Care & Control Center often have severe matting problems which are painful and can cause skin problems and have problems with untrimmed nails causing difficulty in walking; and

WHEREAS local groomers are available to assist Animal Care & Control in correcting such problems at reduced cost; and



NOW, THEREFORE, THE ANIMAL CONTROL ADVISORY BOARD HEREBY RESOLVES:

THAT the Anchorage Assembly should be requested to appropriate Nine Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars (\$935) from the Animal Control Donation Account to Animal Care & Control; and

THAT such funds be used for the purpose of providing grooming services to animals in need which are in the care and custody of Animal Care & Control.
