The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) has received a grant award from the Alaska Department of Public Safety for an amount not to exceed \$175,000. DHHS is contributing \$3,848, as a non-required matching contribution to cover the Indirect Governmental Cost associated with the grant. The period of the grant is from July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012.

The funds for this grant are available for use by any Municipality within the State of Alaska (SOA) through a Federal Office of Violence Against Women grant and the State general funds for Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) Forensic Examinations. These funds will be paid to the Municipality of Anchorage on a cost reimbursable basis.

Under the terms of the grant, DHHS will verify the billing to the SOA Division of Alaska State Troopers by following specific requirements, such as: verifying SART examinations are authorized by the APD and the billing items of the examination are acceptable for reimbursement. The complete list of acceptable and unacceptable items for reimbursement is listed in the letter from the SOA Division of Alaska State Troopers attached as Appendix A.

### Dear Chief of Police:

The Alaska State Troopers (AST) is announcing the availability of funds to reimburse municipal police departments for the payment of specific costs associated with pediatric and adult SART examinations.

Reimbursement by AST is restricted to the payment of reasonable and customary costs of the following procedures, specific to only the forensic portion of a forensic medical examination, conducted for the purpose of collecting evidence to establish the crime of sexual assault or sexual abuse of a minor:

- Head-to-toe physical assessment (related only to the sexual assault) with colposcope examination of anogenital area;
- Completion of all necessary steps in the state authorized sexual assault evidence collection kit:
- Photographs of genital and non-genital injuries;
- Wet mounts for yeast infections, bacterial vaginosis (BV), and trichomoniasis ("trich");
- Cultures for gonorrhea and chlamydia when there are cervical abnormalities;
- Follow-up physical assessment with photography, colposcope examination and wet mounts, if indicated by the initial exam;
- Toxicology screening if warranted based on the history provided by the victim and if authorized by the officer; and
- DNA testing of mother, baby or aborted tissue if necessary and the Department of Law has been consulted.

Reasonable costs of necessary transportation to and from the hospital or SART program provider to conduct the initial exam and follow-up exam may also be eligible for reimbursement, including transportation costs of a guardian to accompany a victim who is a minor.

Under no circumstances will AST reimburse for payment of costs related to the following:

- Medications of any type;
- Pregnancy testing;
- · Abortions or "morning after pill";
- Treatment of injuries;
- Payments for more than one medical provider, unless the sexual assault exam is done via long-distance (e.g., teleforensics);
- HIV, hepatitis A, B, or C, or syphilis testing;
- Transportation via medical evacuation (i.e., Medivac).

Funds are available through June 30, 2012 or until expended, whichever occurs first. AST will accept agency requests for reimbursement of SART exam costs that were incurred between July 1, 2011 and June 30, 2012.

To request reimbursement, you must submit the following to AST:

- An invoice from your agency to AST. All agency invoices must be submitted to AST by July 31, 2012. Agency invoices submitted after this timeframe may not be eligible for reimbursement.
- 2. A copy of the original invoice from the hospital/SART program provider. The invoice must be itemized in a manner that allows for identification of the services provided and the charge for each service.
- 3. A memo stating that your agency:
  - a. Screened and authorized the forensic portion of the exam including toxicology and any follow-up forensic exam;
  - b. Screened the hospital or SART program provider invoice and the charges that were paid by your agency were for the forensic portion of the exam only; and
  - c. Whether the exam was for a pediatric or adult victim of sexual assault/sexual abuse of a minor.
