**A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND HONORING  
ANCHORAGE POLICE OFFICER JESUS RIVERA III FOR HIS VALOR, PROFESSIONALISM AND  
SERVICE TO THE COMMUNITY.**

WHEREAS, Officer Jesus Rivera III was hired by the Anchorage Police Department in June 2009 and served in parking enforcement until his academy began in December 2009; and

WHEREAS, he has worked mid-shift patrol since graduating from the police academy, is known for his keen sense of humor, and has jokingly described himself as a "Lowly Rookie Street Cop"; and

WHEREAS, while patrolling 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue on September 12, 2010, Officer Jesus Rivera III witnessed a physical altercation among a group of men outside a local bar; and

WHEREAS, when a man brandished a handgun and started firing at another male, Officer Jesus Rivera III announced his presence and yelled for the suspect to stop shooting; and

WHEREAS, when the suspect started running while carrying the handgun, Officer Jesus Rivera III chased the suspect and held him at guard until additional officers arrived; and

WHEREAS, without regard for his own life and confronting a much larger adversary, Officer Jesus Rivera III used his training and superior safety techniques to pursue and capture a suspect without additional shots being fired or further threat to human life; and

WHEREAS, Officer Jesus Rivera III demonstrated courage and professionalism in a volatile, stressful, and dangerous situation; and

WHEREAS, in October 2010, the Anchorage Police Department and its Employee Recognition Board presented Officer Jesus Rivera III with the *Medal of Valor* for exceptional courage in saving a human life and protecting property; and

WHEREAS, Officer Jesus Rivera III displayed initiative, commitment and outstanding dedication to the Anchorage community;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZES AND HONORS:

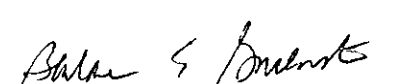
