**A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY HONORING AND
REMEMBERING SENIOR POLICY ADVISOR AND FORMER CHIEF OF STAFF LARRY
CRAWFORD.**

WHEREAS, Larry Crawford served the citizens of Anchorage for many decades, as budget director shortly after unification in 1975, as Municipal Manager under Mayors George Sullivan, Tom Fink, and Rick Mystrom and as Chief of Staff to Governor Bill Sheffield and Mayor Dan Sullivan;

WHEREAS, Larry graduated from the University of Washington with a degree in finance and accounting, became a CPA and came north to Alaska in 1974 to head the consulting practice of Arthur Young & Co., now Ernst & Young;

WHEREAS, Larry also served as General Manager and Executive Vice President of Multi-Visions Cable Company, Executive Director of the Alaska Power Authority, the President and CEO of the Anchorage Economic Development Corporation;

WHEREAS, Larry was the recipient of the Harold E. Pomeroy Award as the Alaska Public Administrator of the Year from the American Society of Public Administration;

WHEREAS, Larry had a private consulting practice doing development of strategic plans, IT planning and implementation, and management and organizational reviews;

WHEREAS, Larry was the Chair of Mayor-Elect Dan Sullivan's transition team;

WHEREAS, Larry Crawford died at home on December 31 after a courageous battle with cancer, leaving his wife Susan Lindemuth and many friends and family;

WHEREAS, Larry's wisdom, wit and friendship will be greatly missed;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES THAT:


LARRY CRAWFORD
