## ANCHORAGE, ALASKA AR NO. 2011-70

A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY STATING ITS CONDITIONAL PROTEST REGARDING RENEWAL OF RESTAURANT/EATING PLACE LICENSE #4293, D.B.A. UNCLE JOE'S PIZZERIA, LOCATED AT 3401 E. TUDOR ROAD, ANCHORAGE, ALASKA.

WHEREAS, the licensee has made an application with the Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Board for renewal of Restaurant/Eating Place License #4293, Uncle Joe's Pizzeria, located at 3401 E. Tudor Road, Anchorage, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly must enter any protest to the ABC Board within 60 days following receipt of the application and March 14, 2011 is the last day for the Assembly to file a protest; and

WHEREAS, preliminary review of licensee's application for this location indicates items and/or incidents appropriate for review by the Anchorage Assembly's Public Safety Committee:

- One or more TAMS card violation(s) for failure to provide proof of server training (See AMC 2.30.125B.)
- More than one incident involving service of alcohol to an underage patron, without checking identification prior to service. (See AMC 2.30.125D.)

WHEREAS, protest by the Assembly is in order to allow notice and opportunity for review by the Assembly Public Safety Committee prior to the exercise of additional action by the Assembly;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

- Section 1. The Anchorage Assembly hereby enters this PROTEST for a renewal of Restaurant/Eating Place License #4293 to allow the licensee the opportunity to meet with the Public Safety Committee of the Anchorage Assembly.
- <u>Section 2.</u> Licensee shall provide the Municipal Clerk proof that Licensee shall be in continued and prospective compliance with AMC 2.30.125B, *Training* (T.A.M).
