A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY PROCLAIMING APRIL 2011 AS SEXUAL ASSAULT AWARENESS MONTH AND ENCOURAGING THE RESIDENTS OF ANCHORAGE TO "CHOOSE RESPECT" AND WORK TOGETHER TO ELIMINATE SEXUAL ASSAULT CRIMES IN OUR COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, Governor Parnell and the Twenty-Seventh Alaska State Legislature continue their commitment to craft legislation and promote initiatives to stem the tide of domestic violence and sexual assault, including HB 127 to strengthen laws related to sexual exploitation of children, domestic violence, and stalking; and

WHEREAS, in Anchorage, the march will begin at Delaney Park Strip (9th & F Street) and end with a rally in Town Square Park;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly recognizes April 2011 as

and encourages residents of the Municipality of Anchorage to "Choose Respect" and work together to eliminate crimes of sexual assault in our community.
