A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RATIFYING EXECUTIVE ORDER 2011-004 AN EXECUTIVE ORDER RE-NAMING HILLCREST CIRCLE AND HILLCREST PLACE IN ANCHORAGE TO CITY VIEW CIRCLE.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

WHEREAS, Hillcrest Circle and Hillcrest Place in Anchorage is considered a duplicate street name problem; and

WHEREAS, three streets named *Hillcrest* exist in the Anchorage bowl area; all three in Municipal grid SW1529; and

WHEREAS, all three streets were platted at the same time, but Hillcrest Drive was the only one named Hillcrest in the plat; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage Police and Fire Departments identified this as a high potential for confusion during emergency response and requested the renaming of two of them; and

WHEREAS, Hillcrest Circle and Hillcrest Place are being considered one street, and have been chosen to be the ones to change; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Department and Street Addressing recommend approval of the request to re-name Hillcrest Circle and Hillcrest Place in Anchorage to City View Circle.

NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves: that Executive Order 2011-004 issued by the Mayor on March 9, 2011 be ratified.



BY ORDER OF THE MAYOR


Hillcrest Circle and Hillcrest Place shall be re-named *City View Circle*. This order shall be effective 30 days after issuance.

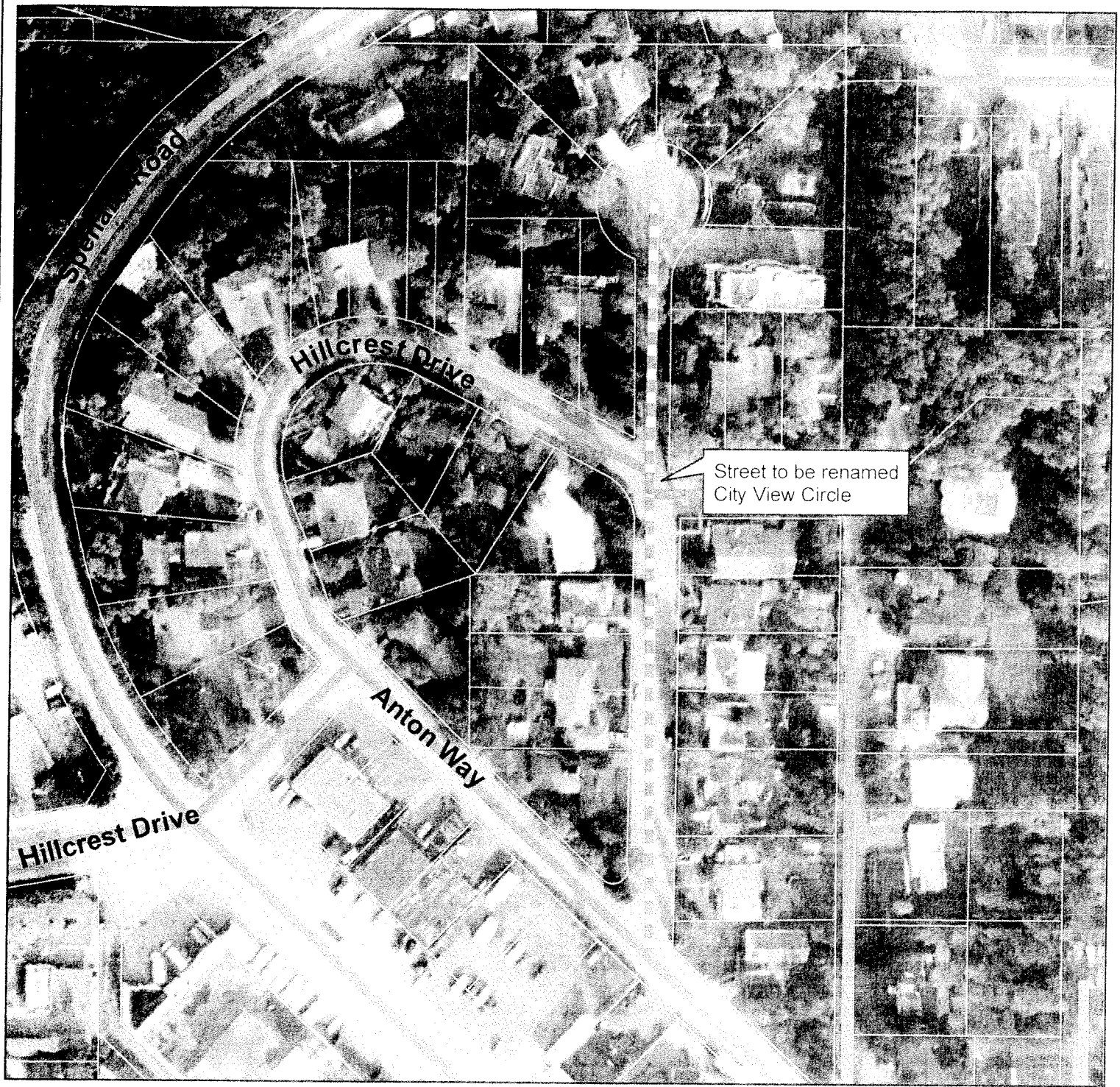

Explanation:

Three streets named *Hillcrest* exist in the Anchorage bowl area; all three in Municipal grid SW1529. All three streets were platted at the same time, but Hillcrest Drive was the only one named Hillcrest in the plat. Anchorage Police and Fire Departments identified this as a high potential for confusion during emergency response, and asked us to rename two of them. Hillcrest Circle and Hillcrest Place are being considered one street, and have been chosen to be the ones to change.

Municipal Addressing sent out notice of this action to the sixteen affected property owners listed by the Municipal Tax Assessor's office as owning property touching this section of street, and soliciting suggestions for the new street name. We then asked the property owners to vote for their preferred new street name. We received a total of ten votes—with the winning street name *City View Circle* receiving six votes.

As per Anchorage Municipal Code 21.15.133.C, the Director of the Community Development Department shall submit the street name alteration to the Mayor with a recommendation for approval or disapproval. In order to reduce potential confusion for first responders, it is respectfully requested that this proposed street name alteration be approved.

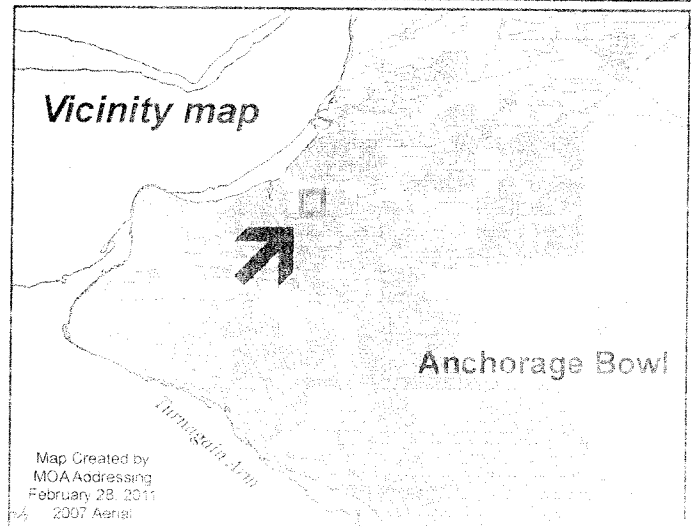


Street Name Change

These streets, Hillcrest Place and Hillcrest Circle, are two of the three Hillcrest streets in the Anchorage Bowl. Anchorage Police and Fire Departments have asked us to rename two of them in an effort to reduce confusion during an emergency response.

Owners with property fronting the affected street submitted suggestions for the new street name, and the name City View Circle won the subsequent vote.

It is respectfully requested that this proposed street name alteration be approved.







Anchorage, Municipal Clerk:

There were a number of mistakes and misunderstandings made during the process that makes the process suspect and the results invalid. The results do not accurately reflect a majority of the property owners intent.





