The period of the grant is July 1, 2010 through June 14 30, 2011. 15 16 The WIC program provides nutrition screening, education and warrants for 17 supplemental foods to low-income, pregnant, breastfeeding or post-partum women, 18 infants and children up to their fifth birthday who are determined to be at nutritional 19 risk. Nutritional risk is defined as the occurrence of anemia, abnormal growth 20 patterns, inadequate dietary patterns, medical complications in which nutritional 21 management plays a role in optimal outcome, major surgery or substantial burns. 22 23 The Municipality of Anchorage, Department of Health and Human Services received 24 the first grant for WIC services in February 1977 and has operated the program 25 continually since then.
