12 **WHEREAS**, the TORA for the AMATS 2011 LRTP Update, executed on May 28,  
13 2010, provided funding for a four-year update of the LRTP in accordance with  
14 federal planning requirements; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Amendment Number One to the TORA for the AMATS 2011 LRTP  
17 Update, executed on October 22, 2010, provided additional funding and revised  
18 the Scope of Services to include project management oversight; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Amendment Number Two to the TORA for the AMATS 2011 LRTP  
21 Update, executed on April 29, 2011, provides additional funding, updates the  
22 reporting and record retention requirements, and extends the end date; now,  
23 therefore,

25 **THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:**

27 **Section 1.** The sum of Two Hundred Ninety Thousand One Hundred Ninety-  
28 Two Dollars (\$290,192) is hereby appropriated from the DOT&PF to the State  
29 Dir/Fed Pass- Thru Grants Fund (231) for Amendment Number Two to a TORA for  
30 the 2011 LRTP Update in the Planning Division.

32 **Section 2.** This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and  
33 approval by the Assembly.

17 An Assembly Resolution is requested to appropriate Two Hundred Ninety  
18 Thousand One Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars (\$290,192) from the DOT&PF to the  
19 State Dir/Fed Pass Thru Grants Fund (231), for Amendment Number Two to a  
20 TORA for the 2011 LRTP Update. Amendment Number Two revises the total  
21 grant amount received to date to \$644,239, updates the reporting and record  
22 retention requirements, and extends the TORA end date through June 30, 2012.  
23 No local match is required for this funding.  
24

25 An update to the AMATS LRTP is necessary every four years to comply with  
26 federal planning requirements. This LRTP update will include the geographic area  
27 covered by the AMATS planning area that includes the Anchorage Bowl and the  
28 Chugiak-Eagle River areas, excluding the Turnagain Arm communities and  
29 Girdwood. The combined LRTP will describe existing conditions; address current  
30 and future deficiencies; make recommendations for improvements to roadways,  
31 public transportation service, pedestrian and bicycle facilities, and include a  
32 financial plan; and will address air quality requirements and other federal planning  
33 factors, including public safety and security. This update will be prepared in  
34 accordance with federal requirements and has a planning horizon of at least 20  
35 years.
