A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY WELCOMING AKUTAN STUDENTS, EDUCATORS, AND TRADITIONAL COUNCIL PRESIDENT ZENIA BORENIN, AND APPLAUDING AKUTAN'S INVESTMENT IN YOUTH.

WHEREAS, the City of Akutan is located on Akutan Island in the eastern Aleutians, 35 miles east of Unalaska and 776 miles southwest of Anchorage; and
