A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AND MAYOR SULLIVAN RECOGNIZING AND THANKING THE ANCHORAGE ROTARY CLUB, RASMUSON FOUNDATION, MUNICIPAL LIGHT AND POWER, DAVIS CONSTRUCTORS & ENGINEERS, INC., ANCHORAGE PUBLIC LIBRARY TEEN ADVISORY BOARD AND ANCHORAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT STUDENT ADVISORY BOARD FOR MAJOR CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE CREATION OF TEEN UNDERGROUND AT THE Z.J. LOUSSAC LIBRARY.

WHEREAS, a major goal of the 2009 Library Community Plan, a community-supported vision for the future of the Library, is to encourage a new generation of library users through the creation of a dedicated space where teens can study, research, collaborate and interact in a stimulating and safe environment; and

WHEREAS, there is currently no dedicated space for teens in the Z.J. Loussac Library and resources are currently combined with pre-school and grade school children; and

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Public Library is focused on the launch of a generational renewal of the Z.J. Loussac Library and does not have the current capacity to address the immediate needs of teen patrons on its own; and

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Rotary Club, with major financial support from the Rasmuson Foundation, Municipal Light & Power and Davis Constructors & Engineers, Inc., joined forces with the Anchorage Public Library's Teen Advisory Board and Anchorage School District's Student Advisory Board to generate community support and private investment to create Teen Underground within less than a year of the launch of the project; and

WHEREAS, the Library provides powerful, out-of-school learning experiences and Teen Underground will be a space for experimentation where young people explore traditional and digital media and use hands-on, interestbased learning to strengthen their creativity and critical thinking skills; and

WHEREAS, the Teen Underground project builds on current research on how teens learn through new media and on the national work being conducted on 21st century skills and the needs of the new workforce in America; and

WHEREAS, Teen Underground will engage young people in learning through the use of digital media, while also utilizing traditional literacies—such as reading and writing—to improve Anchorage's students' participation in building their community, helping each other with homework, and developing networks that extend beyond the walls of their individual schools:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved:

That the Anchorage Assembly and Mayor Dan Sullivan recognize and thank the following contributors to Teen Underground at the Z.J. Loussac Library for contributions of lasting significance for the city and all its citizens:
