A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING ALFRED HANISCH FOR MAJOR CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE BETTERMENT OF THE ANCHORAGE COMMUNITY, PROCLAIMING JANUARY 31, 2012 AS "ALFRED HANISCH DAY", AND INVITING ALL COMMUNITY RESIDENTS TO ENJOY FREE MUSEUM ADMISSION ALL DAY ON ALFRED HANISCH DAY, INCLUDING A SPECIAL RECEPTION FROM 4:00 P.M. TO 6:00 P.M. ON JANUARY 31, 2012.

WHEREAS, Alfred Hanisch, a long-time Anchorage resident, World War II veteran, and important contributor to our community, lived a full life; and

WHEREAS, upon moving to Alaska to work for the Alaska Railroad, he was among the first to drive the Al-Can Highway and later became a 35-year employee of Chevron; and

WHEREAS, Alfred was beloved by his co-workers, church community and neighbors, and remembered as a kind and generous man who shoveled snow at his church, lent friends a hand on projects, and gave away produce from his garden; and

WHEREAS, upon his passing on December 4, 2010, he left significant gifts to the Anchorage Museum, Anchorage Public Library, KAKM Public Television, KSKA Public Radio and First American Baptist Church, through the Alaska Community Foundation; and

WHEREAS, it is a great honor when a public-spirited individual leaves a lasting gift for our community institutions that reflects a love for our city, the pursuit of a high quality of life for all citizens, and the transformative power that one individual can make with their gift; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting to memorialize this generous donation to our community with all the honor and gratitude of the Assembly and Mayor of Anchorage, on behalf of the people of Anchorage as a whole;
