WHEREAS, the Pioneer Schoolhouse is a historically important structure in Anchorage that is owned by the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA), is listed on the National Register of Historic Places, and is managed by the Anchorage Woman's Club; and

The Pioneer Schoolhouse is a historically important structure that is owned by the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA), listed on the National Register of Historic Places, and managed by the Anchorage Woman's Club (AWC). The Pioneer Schoolhouse is currently being restored with \$125,000 in funding previously appropriated from within the MOA Historic Preservation Fund (740) and a contribution of \$47,500 from the AWC. In addition, the Community Development Department, Planning Division has recently received a \$22,352 Historic Preservation grant from the State of Alaska (SOA), Department of Natural Resources through the Office of History and Archaeology (OHA), SOA project #11552, to be used towards the Pioneer Schoolhouse restoration effort specifically for replacement of the roof.

This OHA grant will help to subsidize the cost of the Pioneer Schoolhouse restoration project and enable some MOA Historic Preservation budget already obligated in Fund 740 to be released for other pending Historic Preservation efforts. Further, \$16,589 of the previously appropriated \$47,500 contribution from the AWC has been identified to fulfill the grant's local match requirement. The grant expiration date is September 30, 2012.
