Subject: A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$65,444) FROM COOK INLET TRIBAL COUNCIL, INC. TO THE FEDERAL GRANTS FUND (241) FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ADMINISTRATION STRATEGIC PREVENTION FRAMEWORK IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN

SERVICES.

The Department of Health and Human Services received a grant from the Cook Inlet Tribal Council, Inc. (CITC), for participation in the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) Strategic Prevention Framework (SPF). The grant period is from October 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012.

The SPF is a community-based risk and protective factors approach to prevention that can be operationalized at Federal, State/Tribal and Municipal/community levels. SPF goals include: prevent the onset and reduce the progression of substance abuse, including childhood and underage drinking; reduce substance abuse-related problems in communities; and build prevention capacity and infrastructure at the State/Tribal and community levels. Although the direct recipients of SPF State Incentive Grant (SPF SIG) funds are States and federally recognized Tribes and Tribal organizations, SAMHSA envisions the SPF SIGs being implemented through partnerships between the States/Tribes and communities such as the Municipality of Anchorage.

The three main program interventions proposed under the CITC grant are: Communities Mobilizing for Change on Alcohol (CMCA), a community-organizing program that seeks both to effectively limit the access to alcohol of people under legal drinking age and to communicate a clear message to the community that underage drinking is inappropriate and unacceptable; Brief Motivational Intervention in primary care, a screening and assessment tool designed to identify early warning signs of alcohol abuse in youth and provide intervention services; and Second Order Strength-Based System Change, targeted at enhancing the quality of adults' interaction with students in the Anchorage School District, as research clearly demonstrates the potency of a young person's connection to school as a powerful inoculator against substance abuse and other high risk behavior.
