The Alaska Police Standards Council has provided funding for replacement of HEPA Filters at the Anchorage Police Department Training Facility. This grant is intended to offset a portion of annual HEPA Filter replacement costs in 2012.

Funding will be used to partially reimburse the cost of replacement HEPA Filters that ensure adequate lead filtration of the internal Training Center areas, as well as the surrounding neighborhood. These 99.97% efficient filters guard against airborne lead contamination.

A special condition of this grant is that the department provides matching funds. The total projected Municipal cost is \$286, which has been budgeted in the 2012 Police Department Operating Budget. This grant is intended to support filter replacement during the period January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012.
