Subject: A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000) AS A DONATION FROM NORTHRIM BANK TO THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, MISCELLANEOUS OPERATIONAL GRANTS FUND (261) TO BE USED FOR THE MAYOR'S EDUCATION SUMMIT.

The Mayor's Education Summit is focused on engaging the community to identify ways in which it believes student performance can improve. The initiative involves three phases, the first of which was a Summit held November 2011. Phase two is a series of six community discussions that will take place throughout Anchorage during the month of February 2012. Citizens' comments then will serve as input to formulating recommendations that will be finalized June 2012 at the Capstone Summit to be held in Anchorage, Alaska.

The private sector has underwritten the cost for the eight months of work involved in this initiative. This Assembly action will approve receipt of a contribution from Northrim Bank in the amount of \$5,000 toward this initiative.
