
1 **A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING FOUR**

6 **THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:**

8 **Section 1.** FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000) of Federal Seized
9 and Forfeited Monies is appropriated to the Federal/State Fine and Forfeiture Fund (257)
10 for use by the Anchorage Police Department for special operations related to crime
11 investigations.

13 **Section 2.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by
14 the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

4 **Subject:** A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE
5 APPROPRIATING FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000)
6 OF FEDERAL SEIZED AND FORFEITED MONIES TO THE
7 FEDERAL/STATE FINE AND FORFEITURE FUND (257) FOR USE BY
8 THE ANCHORAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

11 The Anchorage Police Department requests appropriation of the sum of FOUR
12 HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000) to the Federal/State Fine and Forfeiture
13 Fund (257). This sum is from seized and forfeited monies that have been awarded to the
14 Anchorage Police Department by the U.S. Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) through
15 state and federal judicial proceedings as a result of joint DEA and Anchorage Police
16 narcotics interdiction operations.
17

18 The United States Attorney General is authorized under asset forfeiture provisions of the
19 Comprehensive Crime Control Act of 1984, the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1986, Title 21 of
20 the United States Code, and the Tariff Act of 1930 to transfer forfeited property. The
21 transfer must be to local law enforcement agencies that participate directly in seizure or
22 forfeiture of the property. The Attorney General exercises final authority over the official
23 retention and transfer of forfeited property to local law enforcement and establishes the
24 guidelines and limitations for its use.

26 Appropriated funds will be used for specialized operations which include equipment,
27 communications, weapons, protective gear, drug buy funds, overtime and benefits for
28 Anchorage Police employees assigned to Federal Task Force agencies, and specialized
29 training and travel related to investigations and Task Force agencies.
