The Anchorage Police Department requests appropriation of the sum of FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000) to the Federal/State Fine and Forfeiture Fund (257). This sum is from seized and forfeited monies that have been awarded to the Anchorage Police Department by the U.S. Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) through state and federal judicial proceedings as a result of joint DEA and Anchorage Police narcotics interdiction operations.

The United States Attorney General is authorized under asset forfeiture provisions of the Comprehensive Crime Control Act of 1984, the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1986, Title 21 of the United States Code, and the Tariff Act of 1930 to transfer forfeited property. The transfer must be to local law enforcement agencies that participate directly in seizure or forfeiture of the property. The Attorney General exercises final authority over the official retention and transfer of forfeited property to local law enforcement and establishes the quidelines and limitations for its use.

Appropriated funds will be used for specialized operations which include equipment, communications, weapons, protective gear, drug buy funds, overtime and benefits for Anchorage Police employees assigned to Federal Task Force agencies, and specialized training and travel related to investigations and Task Force agencies.
