7 (\$25,000) TO THE STATE DIR/FED PASS-THRU GRANTS FUND (231) FOR
8 THE PRINTING OF THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION PLAN AND THE
9 GOVERNMENT HILL NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN, AND A CONTRIBUTION OF

17 **WHEREAS**, as part of the current effort to upgrade the MOA CityView Geographic
18 Information System, the Community Development Department desires to develop
19 a historic preservation module within the CityView software to electronically track
20 and manage historic properties; now, therefore;

22 **THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:**
23

24 **Section 1:** The sum of TWENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$27,000)
25 from a State of Alaska Historic Preservation Grant is hereby appropriated to the
26 Areawide General CIP Fund (401) for the MOA CityView GIS Project.
27

28 **Section 2:** The sum of TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000) from a
29 State of Alaska Historic Preservation Grant, and a contribution of ONE
30 THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FORTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$1,144) from the 2011
31 Community Development Operating Budget in the Areawide General Fund (101) is
32 hereby appropriated to State Dir/Fed Pass-Thru Grants Fund (231) for the printing
33 of the Historic Preservation Plan and the Government Hill Neighborhood Plan.

35 **Section 3:** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage
36 and approval by the Assembly.

21 The municipal Community Development Department, Planning Division has
22 received a grant from the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources,
23 Historic Preservation Office to support the development of a historic preservation
24 module within the CityView Geographic Information System software for use in
25 evaluating buildings and properties that may be affected by the construction of the
26 proposed Knik Arm Bridge. A capital project managed by the Information
27 Technology Department is currently underway to upgrade CityView to expand the
28 use of the software to include the electronic tracking and management of historic
29 properties as well as various types of licenses. Funding from this grant will be
30 utilized towards the effort. In addition, the grant also provides funding for the
31 printing of the Historic Preservation Plan and the Government Hill Neighborhood
32 Plan.

34 Period of performance is from July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2013, and there is no
35 local match requirement. A \$1,144 contribution from the 2011 Community
36 Development Department operating budget is being appropriated to cover the cost
37 of Central Services Intragovernmental Charges (IGCs) not reimbursable by the
38 grant.
