ANCHORAGE, ALASKA AR NO. 2012–74

A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING THE 2012 STATE LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, AS ADOPTED UNDER AR 2011-295(S), TO ADD A CAPITAL REQUEST FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE EKLUTNA BRIDGE.

WHEREAS, the 2012 State Legislative Program for the Municipality of Anchorage was adopted on November 8, 2011 as revised and set out in AR 2011-295(S); and

WHEREAS, the Eklutna Bridge on the Old Glenn Highway is used regularly by local residents and is now in danger of closure due to significant structural problems; and

WHEREAS, the Eklutna Bridge was acquired by the Municipality in 1985, is the only major bridge owned by the Municipality and is on a state highway; and

WHEREAS, although the bridge operates under specific weight limits and has been on the AMATS project list for over ten years, recent analysis shows even those weight limits may be unsafe; and

WHEREAS, the age and condition of the bridge make it prohibitive to repair; and

WHEREAS, alternative access for local residents is via the Glenn Highway, Alaska Route 1 overpass, and work on the overpass is now being contracted for by the State, with periods of closure and limited access anticipated; and

WHEREAS, adequate public safety, including police and fire protection, and emergency evacuation routing, are in jeopardy unless alternate access for local residents across the Eklutna Bridge on the Old Glenn Highway is assured;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY HEREBY RESOLVES that the 2012 State Legislative Program for the Municipality of Anchorage is revised to incorporate the replacement of the Eklutna Bridge as a project of public safety importance to the Municipality and its residents as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The 2012 State Legislative Program for the Municipality of Anchorage, Capital Budget Requests Detail, Public Safety, is hereby amended to include the Eklutna Bridge replacement project in the amount of \$10 Million.

<u>Section 2.</u> This amendment shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly, and shall be included in the *2012 State Legislative Program*.
