RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING ONE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,420,000) FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES (DOT&PF), TO THE STATE DIR/FED PASS-THRU GRANTS FUND (231), IN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, TRAFFIC ENGINEERING ANCHORAGE **METROPOLITAN** DIVISION, FOR THE TRANSPORTATION SOLUTIONS (AMATS) SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TRAFFIC COUNT SUPPORT) PROJECT.

An Assembly Resolution is requested to appropriate One Million Four Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$1,420,000) from the DOT&PF, to the State Dir/Fed Pass Thru Grants Fund (231), in the Public Works Department Traffic Engineering Division for the AMATS Safety Improvement Program (Traffic Count Support). A required local match of One Hundred Twenty-eight Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-six Dollars (\$128,226) will be provided with previously appropriated Traffic Capital Improvement Program funds.

The Traffic Engineering Division is responsible for the collection, editing and processing of traffic data, regardless of roadway or trail ownership. The AMATS Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides funding of this program for six years (2010 -2015) [Exhibit A - AMATS FFY 2010-2013 Policy Committee Approved TIP. Table 3. Roadway Improvements, Item 6: Safety Improvement Program (Traffic Count Support)].

The Federal Highway Administration through Alaska DOT&PF makes these funds available through the execution of a Transfer of Responsibility Agreement (TORA) on an annual basis for collection, analyses, system input, and enhancements for processing and / or retrieval of information pertaining to pedestrian and vehicular volumes, crashes, and traffic studies. Data collected on roadways and trails is used for planning, engineering studies, requests, and is published in an Annual Traffic Report, as per Title 9. This grant provides continued funding for the Data Section and its required endeavors.
