The Assembly Resolution appropriates \$186,250 in Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority funding as a grant from the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, State of Alaska. This grant funds paratransit services, software updates, IVRs and mobile display terminals (MDT). The match amounts for the software updates (\$7,300), and IVRS (\$18,000) are to be provided from previously approved state and federal grants. The MDTs will be funded from \$136,183 of previously approved state and federal grants. Additionally, \$20,717 is appropriated from the Areawide General Fund providing \$2,376 to the Public Transportation Capital Projects Fund to fund support by Municipal Central Service Agencies to this grant project and \$18,341 to the State Direct/Federal Pass-through Grants Fund to fund the match of \$16,858 and \$1,483 to fund support by Municipal Central Service Agencies.
