**A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND  
THANKING TREVOR STORRS FOR HIS COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP AND NINE YEARS  
OF SERVICE AS THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE ALASKAN AIDS ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, the Alaskan AIDS Assistance Association, known now as Four A's, was established in 1985 as the first organization in Alaska dedicated to responding to the needs of our community for: (1) Services to individuals living with HIV/AIDS and their families, and (2) Eliminating the transmission of HIV and its stigma; and

WHEREAS, through the leadership of Trevor Storrs as Executive Director for over 9 years, Four A's continues to protect and improve the quality of life for those living with HIV/AIDS through compassion, respect, innovation, collaboration and competency -- the core values that guide the Board of Directors, Staff, and Volunteers; and

WHEREAS, on February 26, 2011, Four A's celebrated its 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary and currently provides direct services to over 305 persons living with HIV/AIDS and their families, and prevention services statewide to well over 30,000 persons annually; and

WHEREAS, Trevor Storrs has truly made a positive difference in our community and with his leadership, Four A's is at the forefront of HIV Prevention in Alaska, leading the battle to eliminate new infections and turning the page to the future of HIV prevention with increasing optimism for a healthy Alaska; and

WHEREAS, Trevor Storrs further serves our community as Co-Chair of the Anchorage Coalition on Homelessness whose mission it is to provide a continuum of support to prevent homelessness and connect the homeless to safe, secure and affordable housing;

for his outstanding service as the Executive Director of Four A's for more than nine years, and welcomes his voice on the issues of important community dialogue within Alaska.
