14 (\$1,900), is appropriated from the State of Alaska, Alaska Police Standards  
15 Council to the State Grants Fund (231), Anchorage Police Department, for a  
16 Training Table grant.

18 Section 2. That the sum of FORTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$42), is appropriated  
19 from the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area Fund (151), 2012  
20 Anchorage Police Department Operating Budget as a contribution to the State  
21 Grants Fund (231), Anchorage Police Department.

23 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and  
24 approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

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14 The Alaska Police Standards Council has provided funding for the purchase of  
15 tables at the APD Training Center. This grant is intended to offset a portion of  
16 the costs of replacement tables at the Training Center in 2012.

18 A special condition of this grant is that the department provides matching funds.  
19 The total projected Municipal cost is \$42, which has been budgeted in the 2012  
20 Police Department Operating Budget. This grant is intended to support the  
21 purchase of Training Tables during the period January 1, 2012 through  
22 December 31, 2012.
