Subject: TITLE 11 revision

Hello,

My name is Burim Limani, owner- operator of taxicab#189, chauffeur license # 7520.

In recent talks regarding the possibility of TITLE 11 changes, I would like the Commission to take under consideration to advise the Anchorage Assembly to make changes to TITLE 11.20.037-Non-transferable permits.

Currently, these permits are not transferable to anyone for any reason nor are they able to be leased or rented. These permits were issued by auctioning them to the highest bidders which at times went nearly \$100,000 dollars. I think these permits should become transferable just like the "legacy" permits pre year 1994 for couple of reasons:

1. The permits can be transferred to an LLC or any other business entity which will prevent and protect the permit owner from any personal lawsuits and liabilities if it were to be involved in an accident.
2. If a permit holder were to be ill or injured and could not return to work for an extensive period, there is a high possibility that they will lose the permit if they are not in operation.

I have personally experienced both of these scenarios and could have easily bankrupted me and my family. By my count, there are at least 29 regular non-transferable permits and several of the wheelchair accessible-non-transferable permits that have not renewed in the past several years for many reasons including the two I have. All of these people could have gotten a little bit or all of their investments back had they been able to sell or lease their permits. I am sure other permit holders do have other opinions and ideas which is another reason that this topic merits at least a discussion.
