## PUBLIC SAFETY LEVIES ON THE 2025 BALLOT





- We rely on ~100 pieces of heavy machinery to keep streets safe and clear
- A majority of our fleet is outdated past its recommended life span.
- Prop 10 would sustainably replace about seven heavy machinery vehicles a year.



### **Police Vehicle Levy**

- APD's fleet is ~500 vehicles. Many are in disrepair with over 200k miles.
- Currently, officers have to pause midshift to switch cars with mechanical issues which can affect response times.
- Prop 11 would sustainably replace and retire about 40 vehicles a year.

#### **ROADS & INFRASTRUCTURE**

Prop 2: Roads and storm drainage.

Maintaining 1,000+ miles of roads and 15,000+ stormwater drainage structures. (\$8.32/\$100k in assessed home value)

**Prop 6: Senior center and libraries.** Renovations and repairs. (\$0.50/\$100k in assessed home value)

**Prop 8: Girdwood Service Area.** Road improvements paid for only by Girdwood residents. (Girdwood only: \$24.35/\$100k in assessed home value)

#### **PUBLIC SAFETY**

Prop 4: Police bond. Police response and services, including police building upgrades. (\$0.62/\$100k in assessed home value)

Prop 5: Areawide safety bond. From ambulance replacement to school zone protections. (\$2.05/\$100k in assessed home value)

Prop 7: Fire bond. Replacement and maintenance for fire engines and life-saving equipment. (\$0.46/\$100k in assessed home value)

#### PARKS & TRAILS

Prop 3: Parks and Rec bond. Improving parks and trails, from Eastchester and Nunaka to Goose Lake, Kincaid, and Town Square Park. (\$2.44/\$100k in assessed home value)

Prop 9: Chugach Access bond. Better access to our backyard state park. (\$.06/\$100k in assessed home value)
