MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE PROCLAMATION OF ADDITIONAL EMERGENCY ORDER EO-01 IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19

ISSUED BY THE MAYOR OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE PURSUANT TO ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.80.060H.

I HEREBY PROCLAIM THE FOLLOWING EMERGENCY REGULATIONS TO BE EFFECTIVE AS OF 5:00 P.M. ON MONDAY, MARCH 16, 2020, TO PRESERVE LIFE IN AND ADJACENT TO THE MUNICIPALITY. THE FOLLOWING EMERGENCY REGULATIONS HAVE THE POWER OF LAW, SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL 11:59 P.M. ON TUESDAY, MARCH 31, 2020, AND SHALL SUPERSEDE ALL CONFLICTING LAWS DURING THE EXISTENCE OF THIS EMERGENCY.

1. All bars, breweries, restaurants, food and beverage kiosks, and other establishments serving food or beverages within the Municipality shall be closed to the public for dine-in service. All buffets and salad-bars shall be closed to self-service. This order does not forbid otherwise lawful drive-thru, take-out, or delivery services. A copy of this order or a sign conveying the closure information shall be conspicuously posted by the owner, operator, manager, or other person having control of an establishment subject to this order.
 - o This regulation does not apply to grocery stores (except as to self-service buffets and salad bars within), employee cafeterias within a business (except as to self-service buffets and salad bars within), pharmacies, or hospitals.
2. All entertainment facilities within the Municipality shall be closed to the public, including theaters, gyms, and bingo halls.
3. All large events and mass gatherings of fifty people or more within the Municipality are banned.
 - o This regulation does not apply to the day to day operations of organizations such as businesses, institutes of higher learning, or daycares that are not already subject to closure.
