Previous Project Updates:

The project kicked off in March 2018 with several outreach events and meetings with stakeholders. The events helped to form an initial set of goals for the Coordinated Human Services Transportation Plan to pursue.

- 1. Transportation systems must support and promote individual independence, freedom, and opportunity.
- 2. Creative and efficient use of funding for transportation systems.
- 3. Increased collaboration between public and private agencies.

Since March the project team has prepared and is currently fielding a survey of transportation providers to gather more specific information about the strength and extent of the transportation system that supports individuals with disabilities, seniors and low income Anchorage residents. The team is also preparing for a few additional focused outreach events to learn more about the transportation needs of job seekers and individuals with limited English proficiency.
