V. OLD BUSINESS

A. Resolution No. 2013-01, a Resolution Supporting Solid Waste Service's Proposal to Offer Customers Bear-Resistant Containers

B. Stream Protection Ordinance Setback Project – Update

Maps were distributed to the Commission at the meeting for review. Commissioners made numerous suggestions and edits to the legend and the mapping protocols.

Commissioner Pawlowski asked if the Commission was aware of and interested in reviewing the ADOT&PF/Statewide Vegetation Management Plan. He suggested that the Commission review the Municipality's invasives management plan. Staff will pursue the latter.
