#### IV. NEW BUSINESS

## A. Reopening of Palisade Fence Ordinance, AO No. 2014-92(S)

Commissioner Sinnott gave an overview of the palisade fence issue and the ordinance history. He recommended that the Commission offer its assistance to the Berkowitz Administration to reintroduce the ordinance to the Assembly for adoption. The Commission discussed what the appropriate vehicle should be for this request, a letter or a new resolution. It was determined that a letter of request to both the Mayor's Office and to the Assembly was optimal. The letter should include photos of impaled moose and copies of the Commission's original resolution.

Commissioner Billman moved to send a letter of request from the Commission for reintroduction of the palisade fence ordinance to the Mayor and the Assembly.

Commissioner Bosch seconded.

The motion to send a letter of request to the Mayor and the Assembly to reintroduce the palisade moose fence passed unanimously as proposed.

#### VI. OTHER BUSINESS/STAFF REPORT

There was discussion from the floor about communicating the Commission's interest in working with the Mayor's Office on any new ideas. It was generally thought it to be a good idea to reach out to the new administration—introducing the Commission and offering its assistance on new issues that may come from the Mayor's Office.

The Chair reported that he is working on responding to the parties concerned about the Commission's resolution (WNRC No. 2015-01) on bear-garbage issues on Government Hill.

The Commission also discussed continuing outreach and follow-up with ADOT&PF on moose-fencing issues and policies in the Anchorage area. The Chair offered to draft a letter of outreach to ADOT&PF Environmental staff for outreach.
