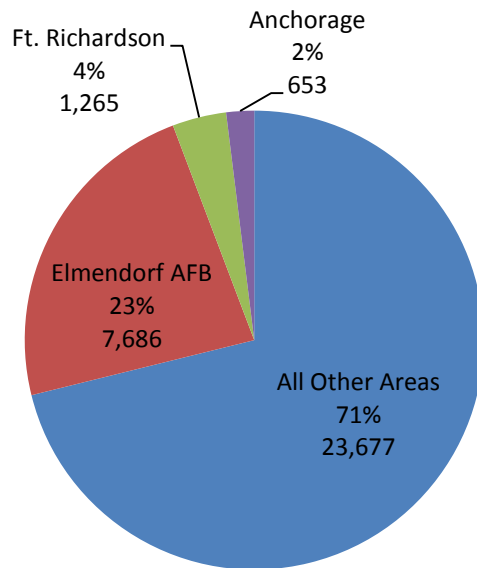

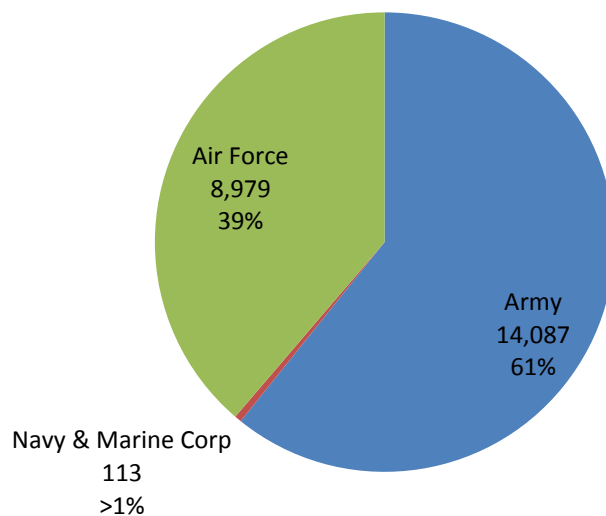

Total Defense Personnel In Alaska by Location, 2009



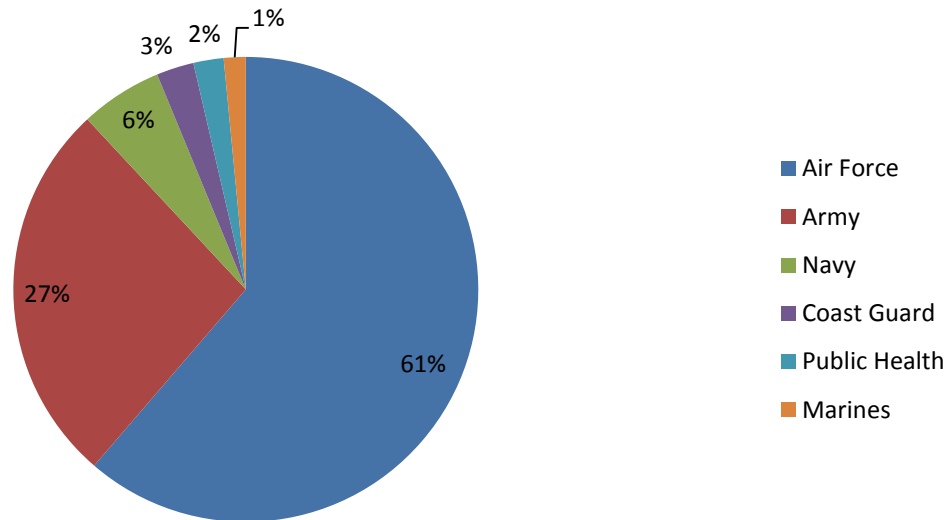

Military Retirees Living in the Municipality of Anchorage, by Service Branch, 2012



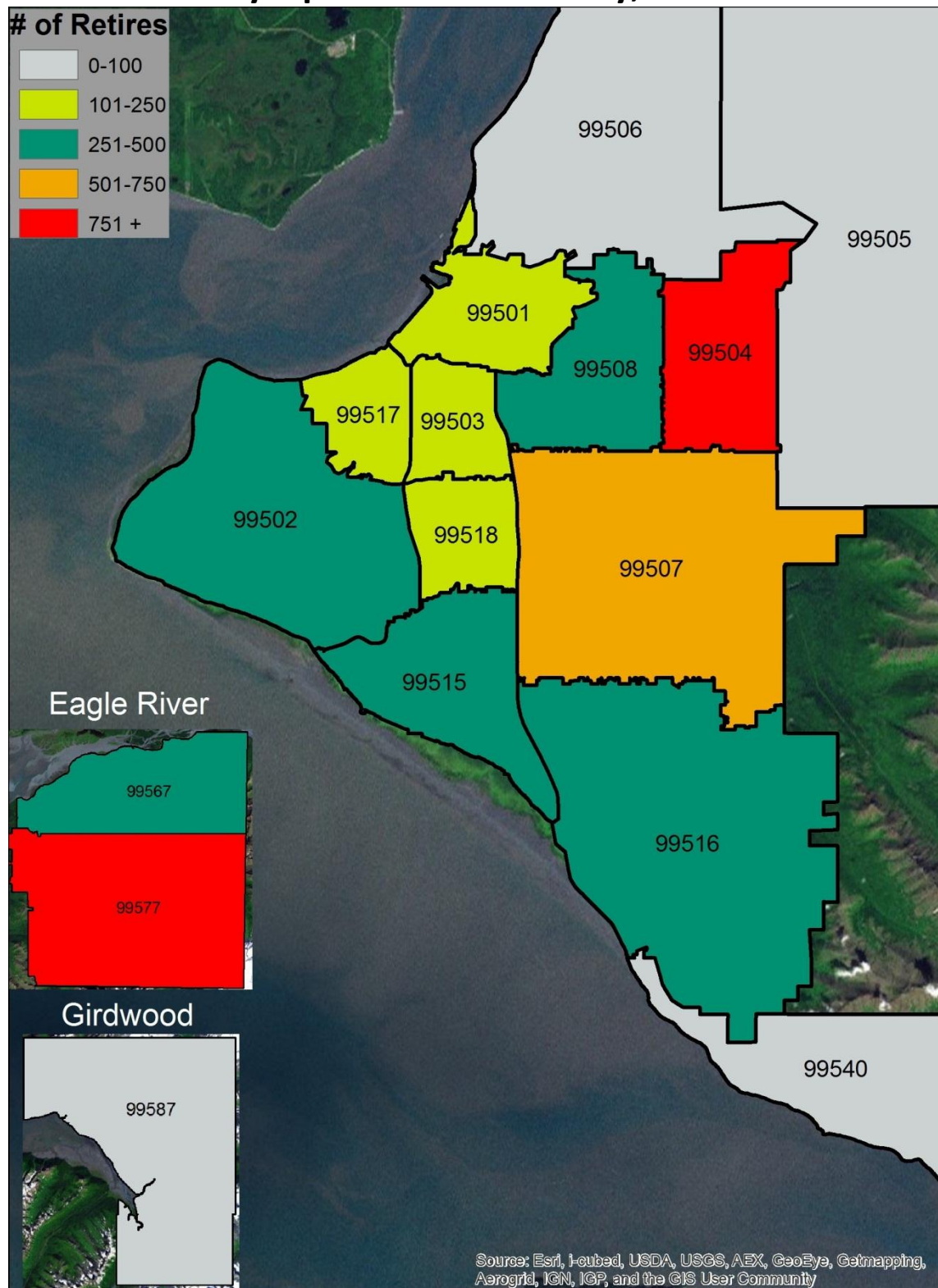

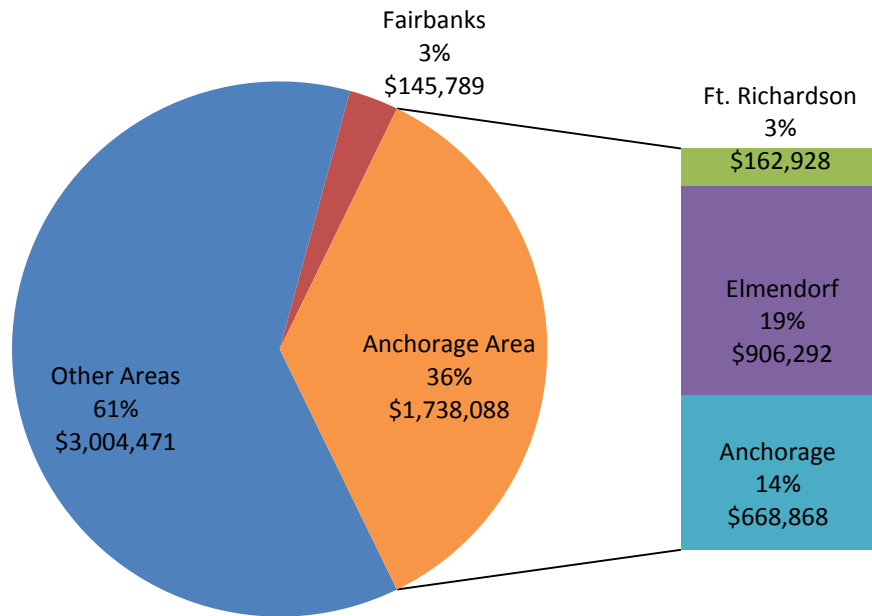

Anchorage Military Retiree Population, by Zip Code of Residency, 2012

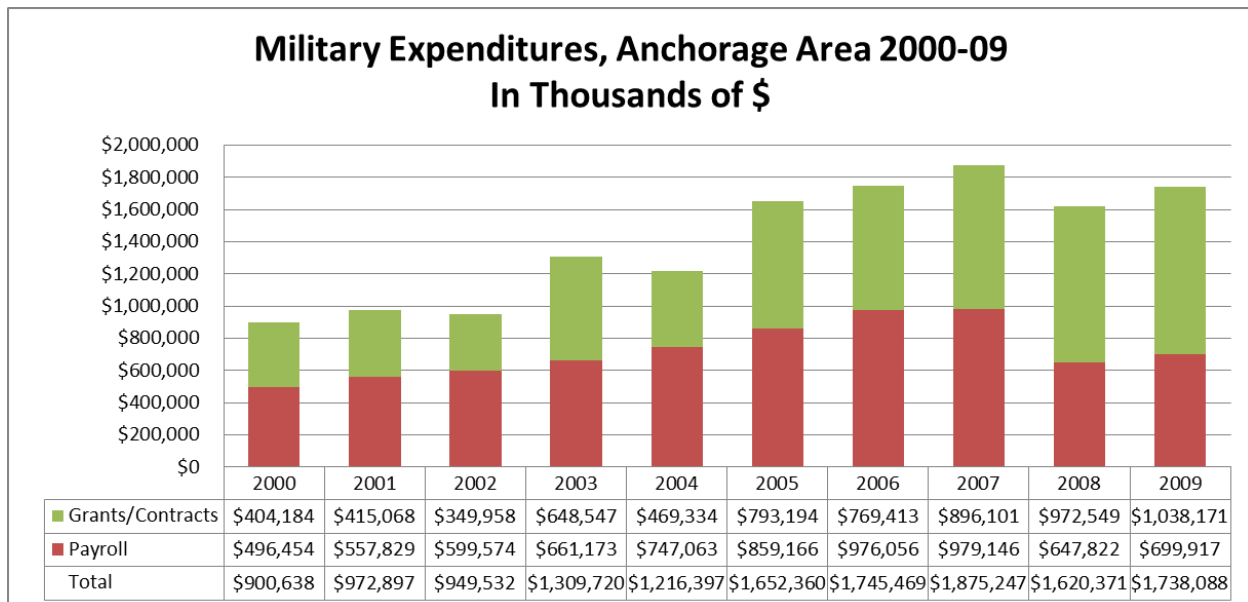
