II. ACTION SUMMARY

A. Regular Meeting of August 26, 2020

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III. OLD BUSINESS

A. WNRC Case No. 2020-01, Land Clearing and Bird Nesting

Steve Rafuse and *Brad Muir* gave an overview of land clearing and tree removal practices by the Parks and Recreation Department maintenance crews and contractors.

Parks and Recreation traditionally have followed the USFWS bird timing window guidelines. They typically do most land clearing and tree removal in late summer through the fall. Occasional projects need clearing in summer. In those cases, they use staff to search for bird nests prior to clearing and adjust maintenance actions accordingly.

Parks and Recreation maintenance activities have never been found in violation of the bird timing windows. Recent Cares Act funds have been used for land and tree clearing projects, which requires adherence to USFWS guidelines. Staff takes necessary steps to avoid bird nests and the nesting season as much as possible.

The Commission recommended that Parks and Recreation coordinate with the USFWS on restarting collaboration with the Urban Bird Treaty agreement.

The Commission asked staff to invite the project manager of the Chester Creek restoration action at Arctic Boulevard to provide an overview of the project.
