Ron,

We talked to our engineer about the meeting with you, Jack, and Ross. We told him you were checking into a purported complaint by adjoining property owner, Remme, regarding surface water drainage and/or problems relating to their septic system.

Your suggestion was to contact our engineer to perform engineering for possible grade changes to an increased retention pond on our property. You also stated at the meeting that you had done a report. Our engineer will need to see the city's report to assess the need for additional engineering and/or grading. He stated that we (Isabelle) should not be required to engineer and/or construct a larger retention pond on our property in order to accommodate and maintain all the perpetual surface drainage from the other five sloped adjoining properties.
