Dear Governor Mike Dunleavy,

It is after careful consideration since the initial declaration on November 30, 2021, the Municipality of Anchorage is formally requesting that the State of Alaska's disaster declaration for the 2021 Halloween Weekend Storm be amended to include the Municipality of Anchorage.

The storm caused significant damage to three local roads in the community of Girdwood. One of those roads is critical, as it is the single point of access to the community's central refuse transfer station, as well as the water and wastewater treatment facility. Emergency work on these three roads was either completed shortly after the storm passed, or is currently being completed. Costs for the emergency work have totaled no less than \$700,000. There is an anticipated additional cost of \$1.5 - \$2.5 million dollars for permanent work likely to take place next summer.

We are formally requesting that you amend the State of Alaska's disaster declaration to include the Municipality of Anchorage, so that we may benefit from some financial assistance with incurred and future costs.
