Project Description

APD Fleet Vehicles - \$3,900,000

The existing APD fleet is aged and needs replacement vehicles for APD to meet their mission requirements. Over 50% of the current APD fleet has reached the end of its useful life. The proceeds of this bond will purchase and fully outfit up to 60 APD vehicles. Outfitting police vehicles includes, but is not limited to; lights, sirens, cameras, communications and computer gear.
