### **DEPARTMENT GOAL/PROGRAM STATEMENT**

Department: Property and Facility Management

### Department Goal:

The goal of the Property and Facility Management Department, as it relates to Wetlands Acquisition, is to acquire, on request, important wetlands areas through either land exchange or fee-simple acquisition, as outlined in the Wetlands Management Plan.

### Wetlands Acquisition:

The Wetlands Management Plan designated wetlands which should be preserved because of their valuable habitat, proximity to existing municipal park lands, and areas of important hydrologic value. These wetlands areas should be acquired over a period of 3 years. The areas selected for acquisition have been choosen because of documented high resource value and have, in some cases, been tracted for acquisition through the reserve tract procedure (21.80.135).

### Asbestos Abatement:

Occupational health and safety agencies have determined that many of the asbestos building products used prior to the early 1970's can breakdown and contaminate the workplace. Working in a contaminated environment can significantly affect the health and life span of people using a facility where asbestos enters the atmosphere. The Department intends to survey, test sample and identify facilities (leased or owned by the Municipality) where asbestos is a problem, develop plans for the removal or abatement of the asbestos and implement those plans to protect the health and life of employees and general public.

## Revisions of Sullivan Sports Arena:

Provide for changes in the arena which will bring the facility into conformance with Building Codes, increase public use and reduce costs.
