### Department Goal:

For the 1985-1990 Capital Improvement Program, the goal of the Capital Projects Office is to identify additional funding required to complete those large capital projects for which the Office has been given responsibility. Unlike most agencies requesting Capital Improvement Project funding, the Capital Projects Office is not the user agency for projects placed in the Capital Program. Because of this, the individual program goals associated with these projects are listed under the appropriate department. Where a user department does not have a Capital Improvement Program we have listed the basic program goals as part of the project narrative.

In addition to the Capital Projects Office program, we have included a preliminary request for Parking Improvements. The newly formed Parking Authority will review this preliminary program and make their recommendations to the Assembly in October. The funding request for 1985 parking projects is included in the Roads and Transportation category in the Financial Summaries.
