Department: Property and Facility Management

DEPARTMENT GOAL:

The goal of the Property and Facility Management Department, as it relates to Wetlands Acquisition, is to acquire, on request, important wetlands areas through either land exchange or fee-simple acquisition, as outlined in the Wetlands Management Plan.

WATER QUALITY IMPROVEMENT:

The designated wetlands which are included in the Water Quality Improvement Program should be preserved because of their valuable habitat, proximity to existing Municipal park lands, and areas of important hydrological value. These wetlands areas should be acquired over a period of six years. The areas selected for acquisition have been chosen because of documented high resource value and have, in some cases, been tracted for acquisition through the reserve tract procedure (21.80.135).
