Working in a contaminated environment can significantly affect the health and life span of people using a facility where asbestos enters the atmosphere. The Department intends to survey, test sample and identify facilities (leased or owned by the Municipality) where asbestos is a problem, develop plans for the removal or abatement of the asbestos and implement those plans to protect the health and life of employees and the general public.
