**DEPARTMENT GOAL:**

The goal of the Property & Facility Management Department is to provide safe workplaces for the employees and safe places for the general public to do business.

**ASBESTOS ABATEMENT:**

Occupational health and safety agencies have determined that many of the asbestos building products used prior to the early 1970's can break down and contaminate the workplace. Working in a contaminated environment can significantly affect the health and life span of people using a facility where asbestos enters the atmosphere. The Department intends to survey, test sample and identify facilities (leased or owned by the Municipality) where asbestos is a problem, develop plans for the removal or abatement of the asbestos and implement those plans to protect the health and life of employees and the general public.
