Mobile Digital Terminals:

Provide proposal and procurement in 1989 of 200 in-car mobile digital terminals for interface with CAD/LEIS, (Computer Assisted Dispatch/Law Enforcement Information System), to improve police officer safety through more secure communications for direct criminal justice computer file inquiry and information to and from the field, and reduce demands on the overloaded radio voice communications channel.

Police Training Facility:

The Police Training Facility programmed in 1991 is planned to meet the projected demand for primary, in-service and regional law enforcement training needs and requirements that will allow participants to meet the standards as set by the Alaska Police Standards Council Act, as defined in the Alaska Administrative Code, Chapter 13 and Alaska Statutes 18.65.130, et.seq.
